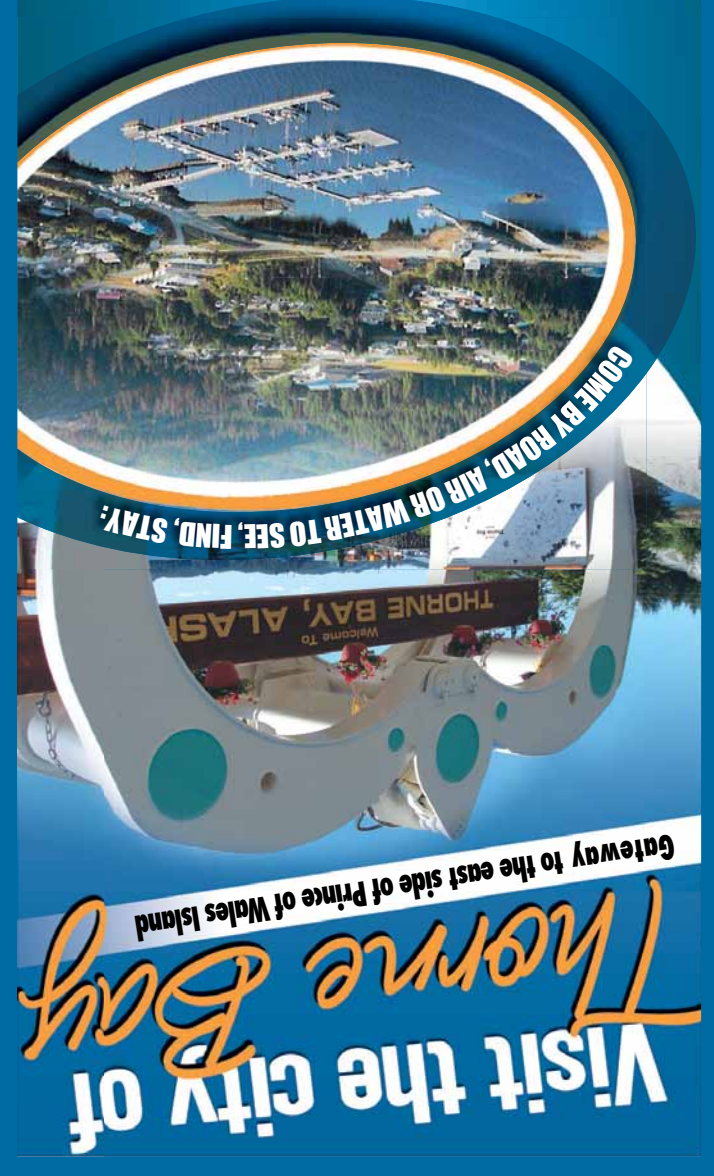
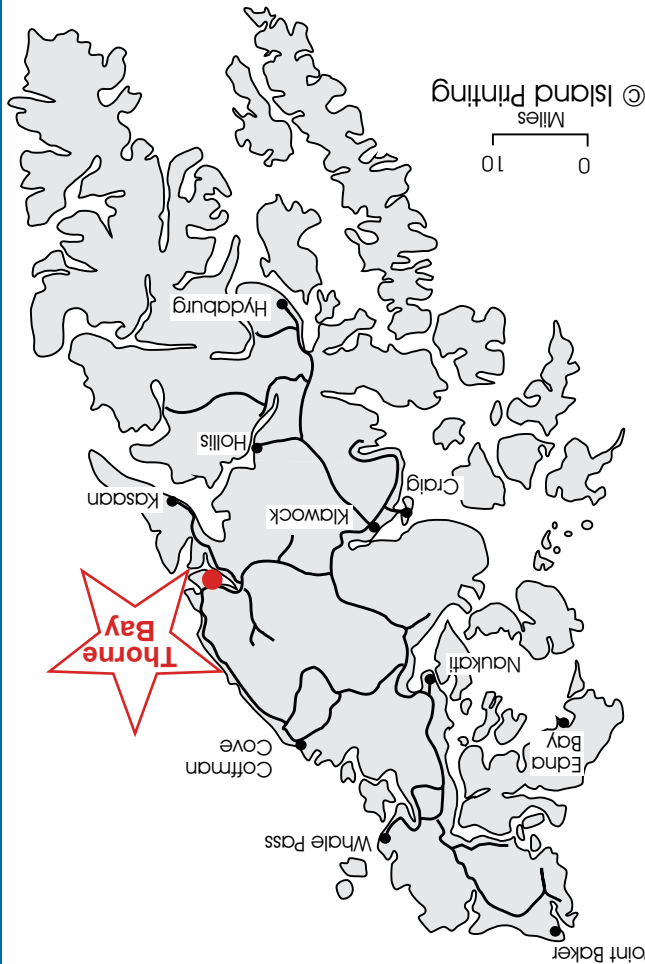

Through the efforts of the Thorne Bay Business Association, City of Thorne Bay Government & the Thorne Bay Ranger District, the "Claw" was saved from the scrap barge to preserve its historical significance. Today the "World's Largest Logging Camp" is a vibrant Alaskan city and the "World's Largest Ever Logging Grapple" welcomes visitors to our community. A Sign Plaza decorates the Grapple with a city map and placards identifying the businesses that make Prince of Wales Island home. The Plaza also honors those that are members of the Adopt a Highway litter control program. From the road turnout, one can see the sorting yard where the Grapple once worked. Picnic tables & benches provide a quiet place to sit and enjoy a view of the bay.

The current city of Thorne Bay evolved from Ketchikan Pulp Company's floating construction camp in 1960. It quickly developed into the world's largest logging camp through the "Big time Logging Era" of the late 1960s into the early 80s with more than 600 employees. As the major logging operations shifted to other camps, Thorne Bay's role shifted to one of a transportation hub for "Woods Run" log rafts. Up to 300 million board feet of logs were annually scaled, graded, & sorted for the highest economic value and were towed to manufacturing plants or export sites. At the heart of the operation was the 4,700 lb. grapple which hoisted whole bundles of logs weighing up to 200,000 lbs. from the salt water.

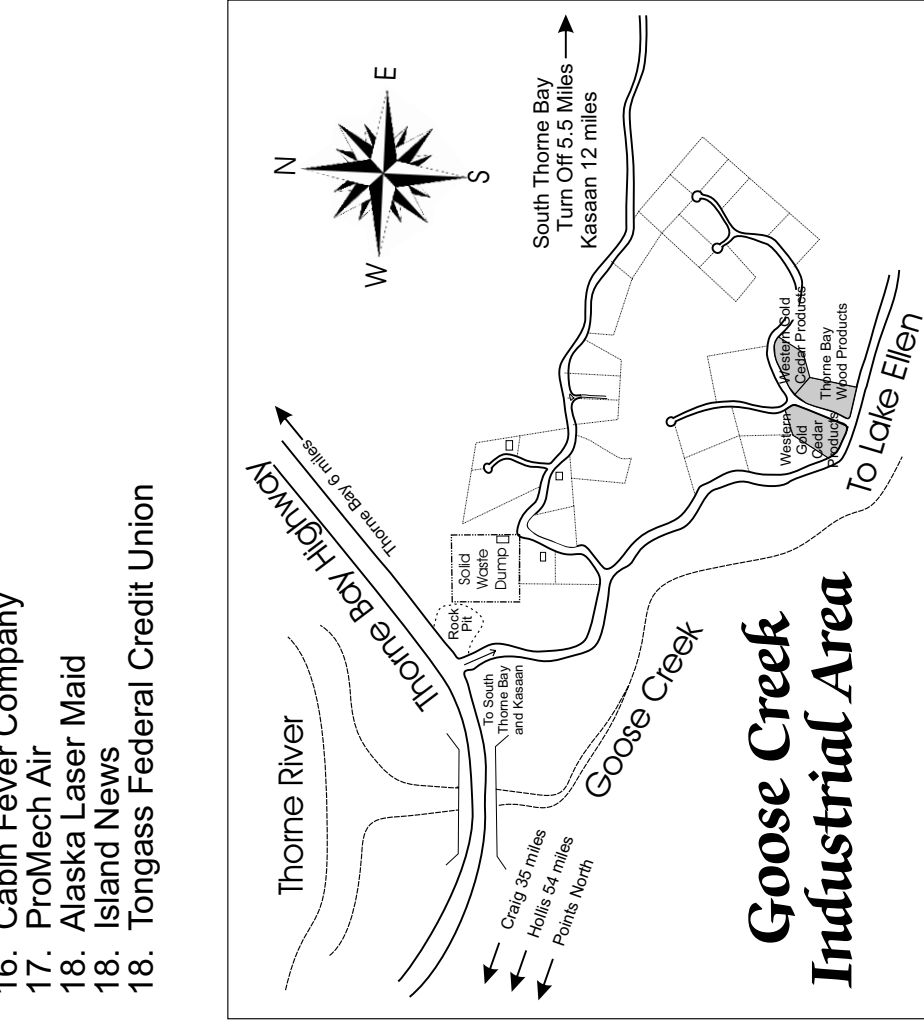

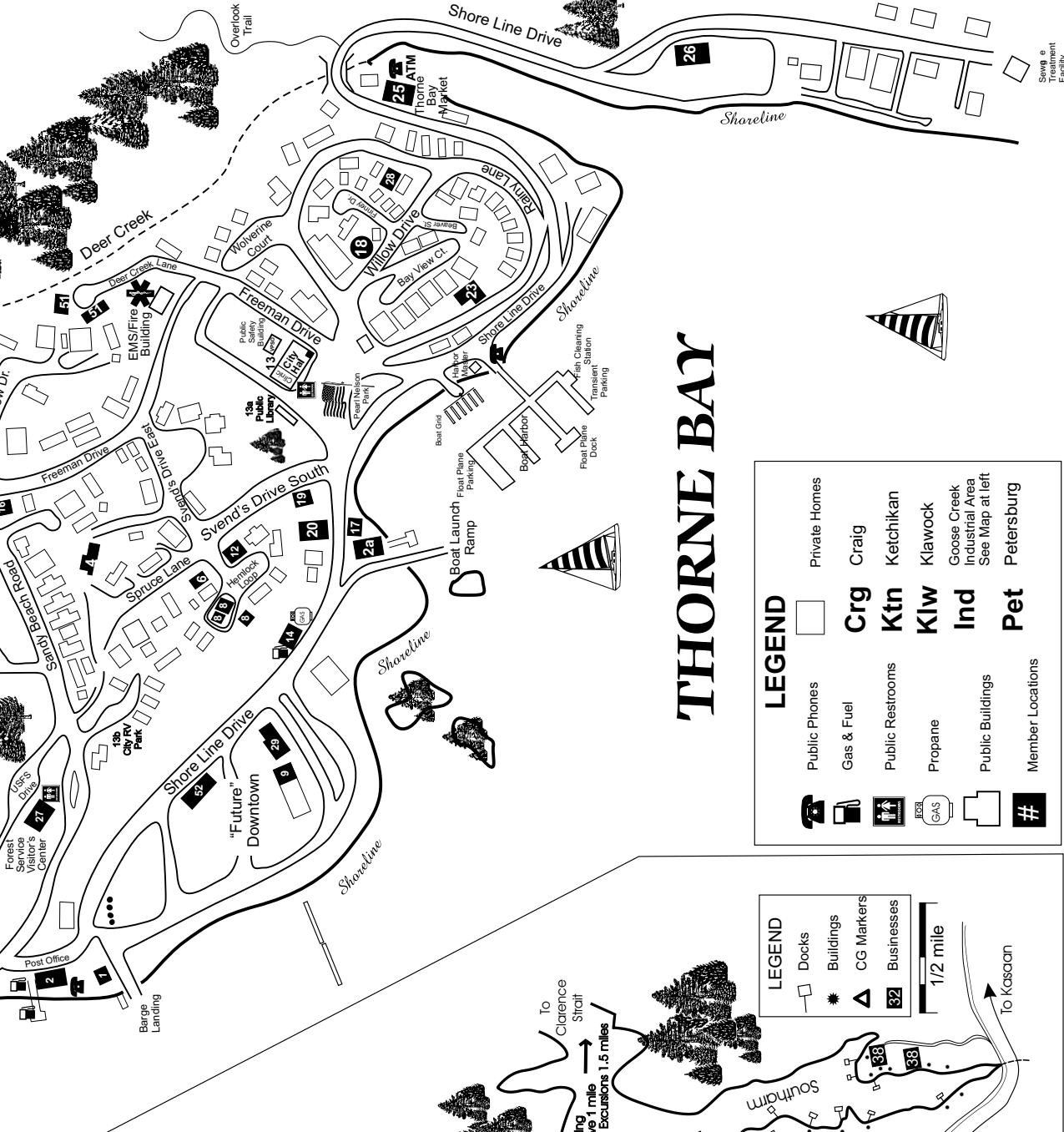
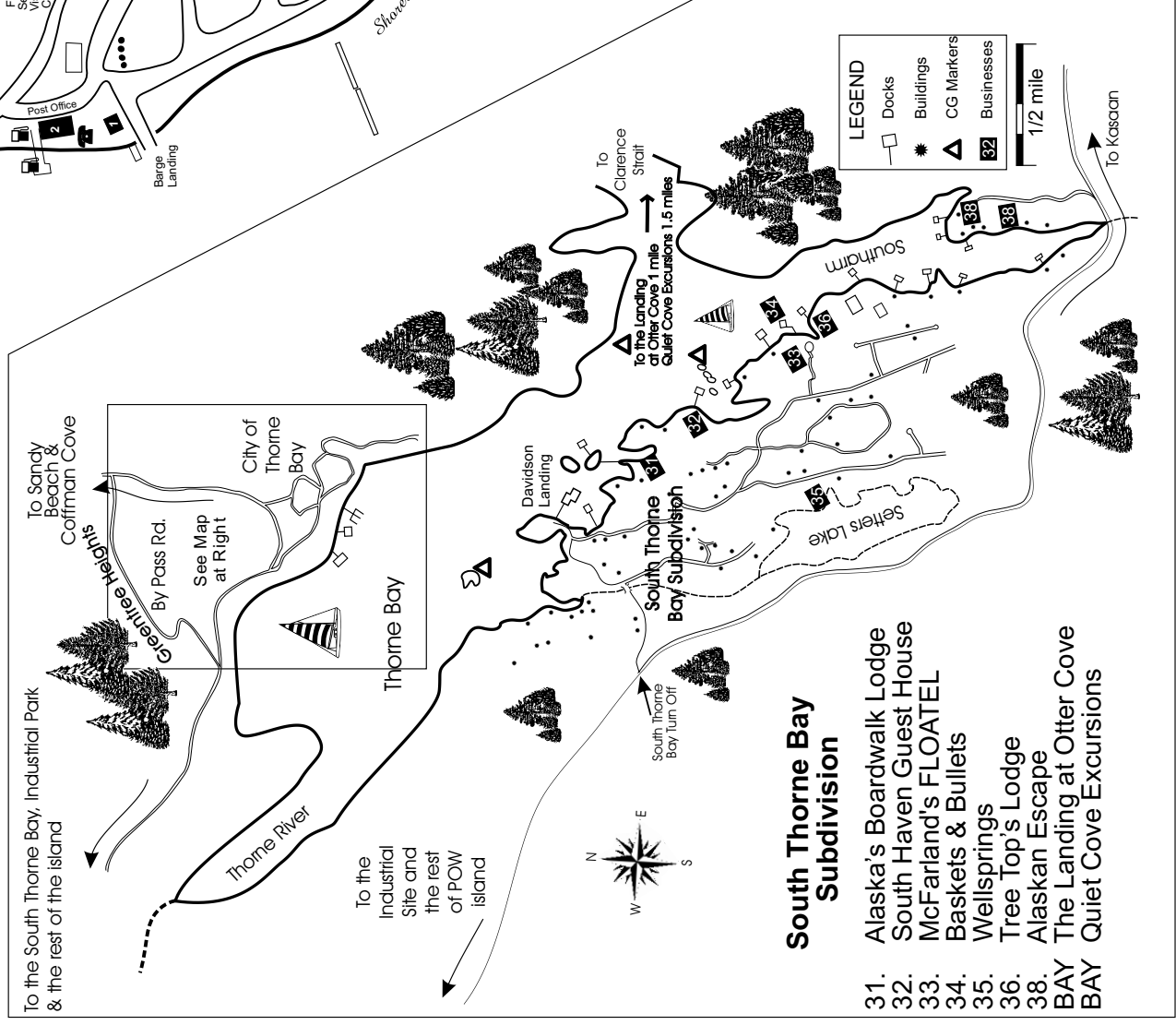
